



## Shore to Ship Bunker Permit PMSC FM 007

This Permit is to be completed and issued for the control of shore to ship bunkering operations and must be used in conjunction with the Port Bunkering Procedures. All Bunkering providers are responsible for the safety of their own employees and are responsible for all aspects of the bunkering process and ensuring compliance with all A&P Policies and Procedures.

This Permit should be completed for each vessel intended to be bunkered. The Designated Person with overall responsibility of the bunkering operation must complete Part A & present it to the Marine Operations Department for Approval. Upon completion of bunkering the Permit must be closed out with the Marine Ops Dept.
