Bye-laws (Regulations of Falmouth Docks 1934)

1.General Powers of the Dockmaster

No Person Shall move any vessel within the Docks without permission of the Dockmaster

2. Vessels to be properly manned

Every Vessel entering or leaving the docks or moving within the docks shall have on board and in charge of her a competent person and sufficient crew for her safe navigation

3. Powers of the Dockmaster

The Master of every vessel entering the Docks shall proceed to the berth allotted to him by the Dockmaster and the Master of every vessel in the docks shall obey all such orders as to mooring, anchoring, placing, loading, unloading or moving the vessel as maybe given him by the Dockmaster

4. Vessels Entering Harbour

Vessels about to enter the Docks must have their anchors cleared and ready to let go, all projecting gear got in, and good and sufficient warps and check ropes in readiness

9. Engine Trials

No person shall work the engines of any vessel in the docks for trial or cause the same to be so worked without the permission of the Dockmaster

10. Competent Person

Every Vessel in the docks shall have at least one competent person onboard her at all times

11. Gangways and access

The Master of every vessel in the Docks shall cause all gangways and stages used for the purpose of access to such vessel to be placed in a safe position, duly protected, and securely fastened and to be so maintained at all times, when in use.
